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Winter's Day Mittens

I have written this free fingerless mittens pattern to match the Winter's Day Scarf & Hat patterns which are featured in my new book 'My Granny Square Wardrobe'.

They are a fun and easy make and are perfect for keeping your hands warm but your fingers free on a cold, winter's day!

You will need:

Yarnsmiths Create Chunky yarn, 100% acrylic, 100g, 150m/164yds
50g each of 4 colours - cornflower blue (A), grass green (B), royal blue (C), christmas green (D), christmas green

6mm crochet hook (US 10)

US /UK conversion

Written in US crochet terms:

US sc (single crochet) = UK dc (double crochet)

US dc (double crochet) = UK tr (treble crochet)

US fpdc (front post double crochet) = UK fptr (front post treble)

US bpdc (back post double crochet) = UK bptr (back post treble)

1. make four traditional granny squares



Please note, the photographs throughout this pattern are taken from the book so show different colour combinations and a different number of rounds for joining.

Using grass green
ch 6, join with a sl st to make a ring.



Round 1:

3 ch in the ring work 2 dc, 2 ch, 3 dc
2 ch, 3 dc, 2 ch, 3 dc, 2 ch sl st to third
of 3-ch,
fasten off.



Round 2:

join royal blue in any 2 ch corner sp,
in the same sp work (3 ch, 2 dc, 2 ch,
3 dc), 1 ch *in the next 2-ch sp work
(3 dc, 2 ch, 3 dc), 1 ch**, rep from * to
** twice more, sl st to third of 3-ch,
fasten off.



Round 3:

join christmas green in any 2 ch corner sp, in the same sp work (3 ch, 2 dc, 2 ch, 3 dc), 1 ch, in the next 1-ch sp work 3 dc, 1 ch, *in the next 2-ch sp work (3 dc, 2 ch, 3 dc), 1 ch, in the next 1-ch sp work 3 dc, 1 ch**, rep from * to ** twice more, sl st to third of 3-ch, fasten off.



2. Assemble your mittens

Hold two granny squares together with right sides facing.

Join christmas green in the bottom 2-ch corner sp, working through both squares.

Continuing to work through both squares, ch1, work 1 sc in the same sp, work 1 sc in every stitch and ch sp along to top, fasten off.



For the other side join in the 2-ch sp, work 1 sc in same sp, work 1 sc in each of the next 3 sts, work 1 sc in next 1-ch sp, fasten off, skip 3 sts, leaving them unjoined to make the thumb hole, join again in next 1-ch sp, 1 ch, work 1 sc in same sp, work 1 sc in each of the last 3 sts, work 1 sc in last 2-ch sp, fasten off.

Weave in ends and turn right sides out.

3. Add the edging

Bottom edge-

Working on the right side join cornflower blue in any stitch on the back of the mitten.

Round 1:

ch 3, work 1 dc in every st and 2-ch sp around, skipping the 1-ch spaces, sl st to third of 3-ch (22 sts).

Round 2:

ch 3, *1 fpdc , 1 bpdc**, rep from * to ** around , sl st to third of 3-ch

Rounds 3 & 4:

rep round 2.



Top edge-

Working on the right side join cornflower blue in any stitch on the back of the mitten.

Round 1:

ch 1, work 1 sc in same st as join and every st and 2-ch sp around, skipping the 1-ch spaces, sl st to first dc (22 sts).

Round 2:

ch 1, work 1 sc in same st as join, and every st around, sl st to first dc, fasten off.

Thumb Hole

Working on the right side join cornflower blue in the 1-ch sp below thumb hole,

Round 1:

ch 1, work 1 sc in same sp, each of the next 3 sts, the next 1-ch sp, move to other side of thumb hole, work 1 sc in next 1-ch sp, each of the next 3 sts and final 1-ch sp, sl st to first dc

Round 2:

ch 1, work 1 sc in same st as join, and every st around, sl st to first dc, fasten off.

Repeat for the other mitten.

Weave in ends and enjoy wearing!
